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College Preparatory Course-taking Across California Counties

As described in [Inequality in Academic Preparation for College](#), academic preparation is a key factor in readiness for college-level work, as students that enroll in rigorous courses while in high school realize both better secondary and postsecondary outcomes. Yet, evidence suggests that rigorous learning opportunities may not be equally distributed across the state, prompting questions about course availability and accessibility. This online appendix provides a closer look at the variation in rates of participation in college preparatory course-taking across public school districts in California's 58 counties.

Data and Methods

Research results included in the full report draw from comprehensive student- and course-level administrative data from the California Department of Education (CDE), University of California Office of the President (UCOP), and the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office (CCCCO), as well as publicly available information about California's K-12 schools. This appendix leverages a subset of these data, specifically data from the College/Career Indicator (CCI)—the primary indicator of college readiness included in the California Schools Dashboard. Information from the CCI includes participation in and performance on AP and/or International Baccalaureate (IB) tests and successful completion of the A-G course sequence, along with six additional measures of college and career readiness. We merge these data with the public districts and schools data files available from [CDE's website](#).

In the county-specific tables that follow, we provide key statistics around the rate of participation in AP tests, the rate of success (score of 3 or higher) on AP tests, and the rate of A-G course completion for all students in each county and by district in each county. We include statistics for three recent cohorts of high school graduates (2018-19 through 2021-22). In some counties, statistics are omitted due to cell size restrictions for reporting on subgroups with few students.

The rates provided in these tables may differ from other published work and/or [CDE's DataQuest](#) due to sample restrictions and/or cohort composition.

Availability of Additional Information

Variation in rates of dual enrollment participation by county are available in a previous report, [A Rising Tide](#), and its accompanying [Appendix of County-level Stats](#). Variation in rates of advanced math course-taking across districts and schools will be provided in an upcoming report by the same authors.
